

Kaokoveld -Untouched

Day 1: Upon your arrival at Hosea Kutako International Airport, you will be transferred to Windhoek. After a brief stop in Namibia's capital, we continue towards Kaliombo Safari Camp, close to Karibib. In the late afternoon you are welcome to enjoy a game drive across the farm, including sundowners. For the night you will be accommodated in spacious safari tents. Dinner and breakfast are part of the package at Kaliombo Safari Camp.

Day 2: We pass Omaruru and Khorixas and end up in the Ombonde riverbed, which is a part of the Hoanib river. This area is known for its bountiful wildlife. One of the inviting spots along the river will be ours to put up our tents.
Camping with full board and lodging in the Ombonde riverbed...

Day 3: After an excursion through Khowarib Gorge we reach our next destination – the Ongongo Falls. This is where we will set up camp for the night.
Camping with full board and lodging – Ongongo Falls.

Day 4: We drive via Sesfontein to find the Ganamub riverbed, a diversion of the Hoanib River. Here a colourful wildlife can be observed. The area is an established habitat of the rare desert elephant.
Camping with full board and lodging – Ganamub riverbed.

Day 5: This day of our Safari takes us to Purros. At Purros there is a good chance of meeting the Ovahimba people, proud nomads who have managed to preserve their original culture. The road takes us along the Khumib river and we finally reach our destination of the day – Orupembe. We will set up camp in close proximity thereof.
Camping with full board and lodging – Orupembe

Day 6: From Orupembe we'll travel via Etanga, Otjitanda and Okongwatii to reach the superbly beautiful Epupa Falls after another 90 km's. We will camp here for two days and explore the area.
Camping with full board and lodging – Epupa Falls.

Day 7: The day starts with a visit to a local Himba homestead. Learn about another way of living from this ancient tribe. Afterwards we set out to explore the area surrounding the Kunene river. At sunset a glass of sparkling wine is awaiting you in celebration of your beautiful experiences.
Camping with full board and lodging – Epupa Falls.

Day 8: We follow the Kunene River and reach Swartbooisdrift after an adventurous driving excursion. We set up camp on a beautiful campsite and settle for the night.
Camping with full board and lodging – Swartbooisdrift.

Day 9: On this day we proceed south. Passing Epembe, we reach the only town in Kaokoveld, Opuwo. This is where we find the first petrol station on our trip. Leaving Opuwo behind we'll head towards Damaraland. We'll reach Hobatere Lodge in the afternoon and set up camp on their campsite. Camping with full board and lodging – Hobatere Lodge Campsite.

Day 10: Hobatere Lodge is situated to the west of Etosha. Today we enter Etosha National Park through the Otjovasondo gate and spend the day game viewing on the western side of the park. This area is only accessible to licensed tour operators. In the late afternoon we arrive at Okaukuejo and spend the night in comfortable bungalows. Accommodation including dinner and breakfast – Okaukuejo.

Day 11: We get up early and spend another day game viewing in Etosha. Etosha National Park is home to populations of elephant, rhino and lion, among a diversity of other game species. In the afternoon we reach our destination for the night, Namutoni Rest Camp. Accommodation including dinner and breakfast – Namutoni Rest Camp.

Day 12: We leave Etosha National Park and visit Lake Otjikoto before heading to Tsumeb, where a visit to the local museum is part of the agenda. Our journey leads us via Otjiwarongo to Okahanja, where we take a walk through the famous Woodcarver's market and then stop by the Hereo graves, an important cultural heritage site of the Herero tribe. A delicious dinner is awaiting you at Capricorn Guesthouse, the perfect opportunity to reminisce about our beautiful safari. Accommodation including dinner and breakfast – Capricorn Guesthouse.

Day 13: After breakfast it's time to head back to Windhoek, Namibia's capital. A shopping trip is possible before we embark on a short sightseeing tour, which then takes us to Hosea Kutako International Airport.
