

Etosha – Abundant wildlife in a unique natural environment

Day 1: 08:00 am - Departure in Windhoek. Travel via Okahandja to Mount Etjo Safari Lodge. Join a game drive in the afternoon and marvel at the diverse game species that have been reintroduced to the surroundings.

Accommodation: Stay in a double room and enjoy dinner and breakfast at Mount Etjo Safari Lodge.

Day 2: After breakfast the journey continues via Otjiwarongo to Tsumeb, known as Namibia's 'garden town'. Here you can learn something about Namibia's rich history at the local museum and then continue to Mokuti lodge, situated right on the east entrance to Etosha National Park.

Accommodation: Double rooms including dinner and breakfast at Mokuti Lodge.

Day 3: A day-trip through Etosha National Park, where excellent gameviewing is possible at different waterholes. Arrival at Okaukuejo Rest Camp in the late afternoon. The camp has a lit waterhole, offering the thrilling possibility of gameviewing after sunset.

Accommodation: Okaukuejo Rest Camp provides comfortable bungalows plus dinner and breakfast.

Day 4: After a short game drive in the morning, we proceed via the towns Outjo and Omaruro to Kaliombo Safari Camp, close to Wilhemstal. In the afternoon a drive around the farm, including a sundowner, is part of the agenda.

Accommodation: Stay in spacious Safari tents at Kaliombo and enjoy dinner and breakfast.

Day 5: After a relaxed breakfast we depart back to Windhoek with a stop at the famous Woodcarver market in Okahandja.
