1st DAY

7th DAY

We'll play for 9 holes. Thereafter we'll be heading north, along the seaside until Cape Cross. Diego Cao, was the probably the first European to set foot here in 1486. Furthermore there are seals by the thousand.

We'll round off the day by walking through Swakopmund and then enjoy a great dinner with seafood.

8th DAY
